

## **WARNING SIGNS**

- Most commonly it is a lump in the chest that is nearly always painless
- A discharge or liquid that comes from the nipple and may be blood stained
- A tender or inverted nipple that is pulled into the chest
- Swelling of the chest area and sometimes of the lymph nodes under the arm
- Ulcers or sores around the nipple area or on the chest

## WHY CHEST CHECK?

Because many men don't know they have breast tissue, and with no routine screening most breast cancers are only found by checking the chest!

Any symptoms you find...

Don't wait, visit your doctor if only to put your mind at rest!

**Early detection means** a greater chance of successful treatment.
