





- Any unusual change in the shape, size or texture of one of your breasts
- Changes in skin colour or a rash around the nipple
- A nipple that has become pulled in or changed its position or shape

 retraction of the nipple
 is normal in some women
- Puckering or dimpling of the skin. Or a lump or thickening within the breast or armpit
- Discharge from one nipple or both
- Constant pain in one part of the breast

REMEMBER Check your breasts... Same day every month!

9 out of 10 breast lumps are NOT cancerous!
