Gift Aid Declaration: If I have ticked the box headed 'GiftAid It', I confirm that I am a UK Income or Capital Gains taxpayer. I have read this statement and want the charity Walk the Walk Worldwide to reclaim tax on the donation detailed above, given on the date shown. I understand that if I pay less Income Tax / or Capital Gains tax in the current tax year than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all of my donations it is my responsibility to pay any difference.
